The academy prioritizes youth training and is equipped with top-tier facilities and international coaches. Its mission is to develop elite athletes, enhance the popularity of squash, and ensure the sport's sustainable development.

Asia's First Youth Squash Training Base, Set Sail on the Olympic Dream Journey

Dream Squash Academy is set to become one of the premier Asian youth squash training bases, featuring 5 top-tier courts certified by the World Squash Federation (WSF). It aims to provide international-standard training and competition experiences, capable of hosting world-class events. The academy focuses on cultivating promising young national players and promoting sportsmanship, highlighting the central role of Dream Squash Academy in promoting the development of the sport.



The Interweaving of Classic and Modern

The squash courts break tradition with transparent glass walls replacing solid ones, and the deep red color of the walls symbolizes the spirit of the academy. The ground floor has a special physical fitness area that focuses on enhancing strength, coordination and explosiveness to meet professional sports requirements. On the second floor, the four windows of the Red Box will display athletes' glorious moments and trophies, carrying the glory of history. The entrance is adorned with a classic vintage British-style door, exuding classical charm.





Innovative Sunken Design Creates Multi-functional Second-floor Space

Dream Squash Court is cleverly designed to be sunken, breaking away from the typical low utilization of second-floor spaces in Asian venues. It creatively incorporates offices, study rooms, a parent reception area, and a tiered seating area, which integrates multiple functions and perfectly utilizes the second floor space. In particular, silent study rooms are set up to ensure that young athletes can pursue their sporting dreams without compromising their academics. The central area serves as a platform for parent communication, enhancing interaction. Post-game, the tiered seating area can transform into a tactical analysis room, echoing scenes from American college sports settings, which ensures that children feel familiar and comfortable no matter where their future takes them.



Innovative Multi-window Design Creates a Bright and Vibrant Sports Space

Dream Squash Academy cleverly ingeniously utilizes natural light through four transparent strips at the top, achieving equal brightness indoors and outdoors. This significantly reduces daytime artificial lighting usage, setting a new standard for energy efficiency and overturning the traditional reliance on artificial lighting in indoor venues throughout the day. The ceiling lights are visually minimalistic and only supplement light when necessary, simulating the uniform distribution of natural light to ensure balanced and comfortable illumination. Specifically designed floor-to-ceiling windows break the limitation of most squash courts without windows. These ingeniously crafted designs collectively create a bright, spacious, and vibrant sports space, providing an ideal growth and training environment for young people.





Green Exercise, Healthy Protection

Dream Squash Academy upholds a green philosophy by selecting safe and environmentally friendly materials. The wooden floor undergoes rigorous testing to ensure it meets formaldehyde emission standards, guaranteeing health and safety. The sports flooring is CNAS certified, adheres to ISO9001 and ISO14001 standards, complies with REACH regulations, and meets the highest EN14904 testing standards for sports flooring, which has exceptional quality. Recyclable woven carpets are used on the second floor, which promote a circular economy and contribute to a green sports environment.
